

Times Table Game

A fun game for practicing the times tables, created by Molli Reynolds.

Materials needed:

- A printed copy of the game board (see below)
- Two to three 'players' (three coloured paper clips, coins, stones, etc.)
- One dice
- Any supporting materials specific to players' needs such as multiplication chart or counting materials.

How to play:

- 1. Decide who goes first (oldest, shortest, etc.)
- 2. Each player rolls the dice in turn and moves their player forward that many spaces
- 3. On turn #2, move the number of spaces that is the answer to the question you landed on for turn #1, continue in this way around the game board
- 4. If you land on a dice picture, roll and continue as from step 2
- 5. If you land on a sad face, move back the number of places written there
- 6. First to reach 'Finish' wins!

Please Note:

- Page 3 has a blank game board so you can fill it in with times tables questions specific to your child.
