Creating a rhythm for your morning lessons will help you and your child to settle into homeschooling for the day. Your child will feel held by the rhythm of your day and the routines within it. Each morning lesson should begin and end with a verse or a song. Typically, the same opening and closing verse is said for the entire year but can vary from grade to grade. Here are several examples for you to choose from.
